## Our Campuses

### Ipiranga Campus

Since 1981, the university has been installed in one of the most traditional neighborhoods in all of Brazil, on the Ipiranga Campus.

Its 17,221 m<sup>2</sup> contains over 70 classrooms and over 30 laboratories, equipped with technological assets for healthcare studies.



### Pompeia Campus

Our beautiful Pompeia Campus was established in 1999, and it houses a Psychology Clinic, a Realistic Simulation Center, and over 40 classrooms and over 15 laboratories on its 13,419 m<sup>2</sup>.

### Promove Clinic

The Promove Clinic has been offering Health services for populations in need since 2002, furthering the Camillian Order's passion for healthcare and social assistance. Here, our students have the opportunity to come in contact with brazilian's healthcare infrastructure through hands-on classes and internships.



### Academic Calendar

- The 1st semester of the Academic Year begins between the 1st and 2nd week of February until last week of June
- The 2nd semester of the Academic Year begins between the 1st and 2nd week of August and ends in the second week of December.

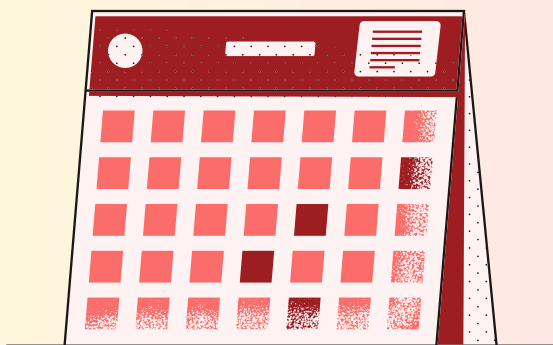

## Enrollment Calendar

The application deadlines for the International Mobility Programs are:

- For the 1st semester, you must apply until **November 30th** of the previous year
- For the 2nd semester, you must apply until **June 30th** of the current year
